Jatropha is a genus of flowering plants in the spurge family. Products and uses of the Jatropha plant include dyes, leather tanning, and biomass feedstock for biodiesel production. Jatropha and extracts may contain compounds that are highly toxic to humans.

Detrex Hydrochloric Acid products are manufactured from synthesized or manufactured pure chemical elements. Our products, and the raw material precursors to our products, are not derived from any Jatropha plant material, or any compounds made from Jatropha. Materials and products containing Jatropha are not used in the manufacture, storage, or packaging of Detrex Hydrochloric Acid products to the best of our knowledge.
