To whom it may concern,

Persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBTs) substances are a class of compounds which possess high resistance to degradation from abiotic and biotic factors, high mobility in the environment and high toxicity.

This class of compounds includes, but is not limited to PCB's, DDT, and Mercury. While we do not routinely test for these compounds, to the best of our knowledge we have no reason to suspect they may exist in our Hydrochloric Acid Products.
