Subject: Proposition 65 Statement

To whom it may concern,

Proposition 65 refers to the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986. This law requires the State to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. This list, updated annually, contains approximately 800 naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer or have reproductive consequences to humans. Products on this list are required to have warning information on their labels.

Hydrochloric Acid is not listed on the California Proposition 65 List of chemicals and, therefore; is exempt from the labeling requirements associated with Proposition 65.
